### Allen and Dorothy Calvin Doctoral Dissertation Awards Guidelines

The **Allen and Dorothy Calvin** Doctoral Dissertation Awards are awarded on a competitive basis to promising School of Education doctoral students to assist with their doctoral research. Applications will be reviewed by the School of Education Doctoral Program Policies Committee.

#### ELIGIBILITY

All School of Education doctoral students who have been advanced to candidacy are eligible to apply. A \$1000 award will be granted up to two applicants per academic year (one each semester) after a competitive review process.

---

#### REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

Three packets, each containing the following:

- Completed **Allen and Dorothy Calvin Doctoral Dissertation Award Application Form**
  - Copy of the **Advancement to Candidacy** letter signed by the Associate Dean
  - Copy of the **Dissertation Proposal Outline Form** (cf. Dissertation Committee Application)
  - A narrative describing proposed **budgetary expenditures and timeline**

#### APPLICATION DEADLINES

- Spring: Application due by USF Census Date / Scholarship awarded in March.
  - Fall: Application due by USF Census Date / Scholarship awarded in October.
